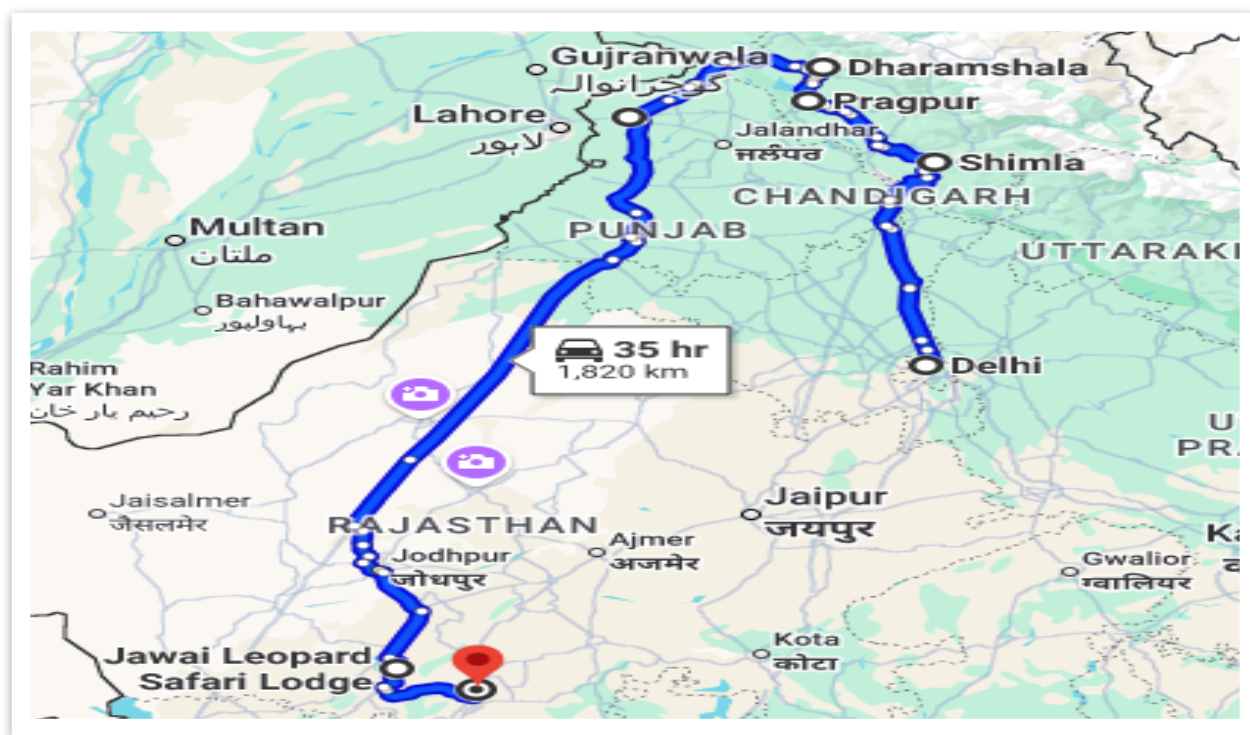

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

Wednesday, 5th November

Day Itinerary

Welcome to India! Upon arrival, you will be met by our representative at the airport, who will escort you to the hotel and will assist you with the check in formalities. Please note standard check-in time at the hotel is 14:00

New Delhi

India's capital, New Delhi, lies on the Indo-Gangetic Plain, within the National Capital Territory of Delhi. Made up of the ancient walled city of Old Delhi and the more modern sector, New Delhi, the city encompasses a staggering array of beautiful buildings, including three UNESCO World Heritage Sites – the grand, sandstone Red Fort, striking Qutab Minar, and fascinating Humayun's Tomb. Architecture enthusiasts will delight in the iconic Lotus Temple. Hear 'qawwalis' (devotional music) at the dargah (tomb) of the Sufi saint Nizam-ud-din Auliya; or wander through the 17th century Chandni Chowk marketplace – still one of the city's most popular retail centres today, famous for its traditional jewellery and saris. The gorgeous Sunder Nursery and Lodi Garden provide calm, flower-filled oases for picnicking.

Transfer to Delhi railway station to board train (Shatabdi Exp – 0740/1057 hrs) for Chandigarh. Met on arrival at Chandigarh railway and drive to Shimla (105 kms/approx. 3½ hrs).

Upon arrival in Shimla, check in at the hotel.

Shimla

Shimla is a picturesque hill station in the Himalayan foothills of northern India and the capital of Himachal Pradesh. Once the summer capital of British India, it sits at 2,200 meters elevation featuring colonial architecture, including Christ Church and buildings along the pedestrian Mall Road. The city is surrounded by pine and deodar forests with mountain views and connected by the historic narrow-gauge Kalka-Shimla Railway. Popular spots include Jakhu Temple, Ridge Maidan, and the former Viceregal Lodge, making it a beloved retreat from the heat of the plains.

Overnight: Taj Theog Resort & Spa, Shimla

Day 3: In Shimla

Half day Heritage Walking tour of Shimla. Shimla, once the summer capital of the British Raj in India offers some of the best examples of British architecture in India including the beautiful Christ Church, the splendidly restored Gaiety Theatre – where Rudyard Kipling once trod the boards and the unusual Railway Board Building constructed from steel and cast iron. The Heritage Walking tour provides fascinating insights into Shimla's history. Starting at the The Ridge, the walk takes in all of Shimla's landmarks, including the magnificent Viceregal Lodge, an elaborate building built as the summer residence of the Viceroy. (Viceregal Lodge and Gaiety Theatre are closed on Monday)

Day 4: Drive Shimla-Pragpur

Saturday, 8th November

Day Itinerary

Drive to Pragpur (210 kms/approx. 5-6 hrs). Upon arrival check in at the hotel.

Later enjoy a sightseeing tour of Pragpur.

Pragpur which is India's first national heritage village, through its narrow-cobbled lanes lined with small traditional mud-plastered fort-like houses, reminiscent of a medieval village. These sunbaked houses stand in close harmony with the wooden facades of other colonial-style buildings. The streetscapes are full of interest and are small enough to be explored on foot with your guide.

As part of your tour, you will discover the large ornamental tank and the active temple nearby, where devotees often gather to chant prayers in the early evening.

Pragpur

Pragpur is a charming heritage village located in the Kangra Valley of Himachal Pradesh, India. Established around the 16th century, it earned the distinction of becoming India's first Heritage Village in 1997. The village is characterized by its well-preserved cobblestone streets, traditional mud-plastered houses with ornate wooden facades, and slate roofs that showcase the distinctive Kangra architecture.

Central to Pragpur is The Judge's Court, an ancestral country manor now operating as a heritage hotel. The village maintains its old-world charm with ancient water tanks, courtyards, and the Taal sacred pond. Surrounding the village are scenic views of the Dhauladhar mountain range. Located near Dharamshala, Pragpur offers visitors an authentic glimpse into rural Himalayan life while preserving its rich cultural heritage.

Overnight: The Judge's Court, Pragpur

Imperial India left many legacies including built heritage. One of these is The Judge's Court, a Country Manor located in a small village, Pragpur, on the edge of the Himalaya Mountains, at an elevation of 2000 ft. in the cool Kangra Valley of the North Indian State of Himachal Pradesh.

The Judge's Court, was built by Jai Lal, a 7th generation Sood resident of Pragpur, whose ancestors had migrated from Amarkot – now in Pakistan - & Sirhind, to found this village in the fiefdom of a Katoch (cadet of the Kangra rulers). The time was when the Raj was at its Apex (1914 to 1918) & India was as mirrored by Kim & Bhageera. The building is a perfect harmony of Hindu and Islamic architectural features mastered over with European techniques.

Day 5: Drive Pragpur - Dharamshala

Drive to Dharamshala (80 kms/approx. 2 hrs). Upon arrival check in at the hotel.

Dharamshala

Dharamshala is a scenic hill station in Himachal Pradesh's Kangra district, nestled in the Dhauladhar mountains. Famous as the residence of the Dalai Lama and Tibetan government-in-exile, it blends Tibetan and Indian cultures. Upper Dharamshala (McLeod Ganj) features Buddhist monasteries, colorful prayer flags, and Tibetan markets. Key attractions include the Namgyal Monastery, Tsuglagkhang Complex, and Tibet Museum. Surrounded by pine forests with mountain trails like Triund, Dharamshala attracts spiritual seekers and nature lovers with its peaceful atmosphere and stunning Himalayan scenery.

Overnight: Radisson Blu Resort Dharamshala

Amritsar

Amritsar is a vibrant city in Punjab, northwest India, renowned as the spiritual center of Sikhism. The city's crown jewel is the magnificent Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib), with its gold-plated shrine sitting amid a sacred pool. Amritsar also holds historical significance with sites like Jallianwala Bagh, commemorating the 1919 massacre. The daily Wagah Border ceremony marks India's frontier with Pakistan. Known for its rich Punjabi culture, Amritsar offers exceptional cuisine including butter chicken, kulchas, and lassi. The city seamlessly blends spiritual devotion, historical importance, and culinary excellence, making it one of India's most distinctive cultural destinations.

Overnight: Welcomhotel By ITC Hotels, Raja Sansi, Amritsar

Day 9: In Amritsar

Thursday, 13th November

Day itinerary

Morning sightseeing tour of Amritsar visiting The Golden Temple - founded by the fourth Guru of Sikhs, Guru Ramdas and completed by his successor Guru Arjan Dev. It is here that people from all over the world come to pay their reverence to The Guru Granth Sahib and take a dip in the Amrit Saras Kund (Pool of Immortality) for spiritual purification. Also visit the Jallian Wala Bagh - notorious for the massacre that took place here under British rule. In 1919 General Dyer personally led the troops to this walled ground and ordered his men open fire on a group of peaceful protestors. At the east end of the garden there is a large memorial built in memory of those who died here.

Later this afternoon, you will witness the Wagah border closing ceremony at the India-Pakistan border, an hour's drive from Amritsar. This entertaining drill – where guards from each side try to outshine each other with their elaborate

posturing, encouraged by the excitable crowd – is a memorable and unique experience. Taking place each day at sunset, the ceremony concludes with a firm handshake and the lowering of flags on both sides of the border.

Day 10: Fly Amritsar – Udaipur via Delhi & Drive to Jawai

Transfer to Amritsar airport in time to board flight for Udaipur via Delhi. (1015-1445 hrs)

Met on arrival at Udaipur airport and drive to Jawai (160 kms/approx. 3 hrs). Upon arrival check in at the hotel.

Jawai

Jawai is a rugged wilderness area in Rajasthan's Pali district, known for its unique landscape of dramatic granite hills and reservoirs. Famous for its thriving leopard population that coexists peacefully with local communities, Jawai offers exceptional wildlife viewing opportunities. The region is centered around the Jawai Bandh, Rajasthan's largest dam, which attracts migratory birds including flamingos and cranes. Ancient temples dot the rocky outcrops, while traditional Rabari herdsman maintain their pastoral lifestyle nearby. With its distinctive combination of wildlife, striking geology, and cultural heritage, Jawai provides a less-traveled yet captivating destination in western India.

Overnight: WelcomHeritage Cheetahgarh Resort & Spa, Jawai

Devigarh
